

Catholic social teaching promotes peace as an essential component of social justice. It calls for the transformation of social structures & systems that perpetuate violence, inequality, & injustice, & for the promotion of a culture of peace, human dignity, & justice.

This year is the culmination of a three-year Social Justice Week focus on peace & conflict. We started with a focus on personal peace in 2023, followed by forgiveness & reconciliation in 2024. In 2025 we are focusing on being peacebuilders in the world.

Over the past two years we have looked at building peace in ourselves & recognising the importance of forgiveness to have peaceful connections with those around us. However, we cannot be content with peace in our personal lives alone when there are global injustices impacting people around us.
