THE 'STAYING POWER' OF PRAYER

Jesus' parable to-day is full of irony.

The widow is a startling character - not poor, not defenceless she goes into court a male arena



she fronts before an un-just judge to demand her due.

The judge is all he should not be.

(Judges were to reflect God's justice 2 CHRONICLES 19:6-7 DEUT. 24, 17)

The widow keeps on returning, moving beyond expected female behaviour - the Greek text says she "blackens" his eye! his reputation!

The unjust judge yields.

This parable is a statement that a disciple's faith is not automatic.

Faith grows and matures through prayer as well as through the practice of justice.

Faith is both a gift and a task.


