A Church Responsive to the Cry of the **Poor -** As the Church marks the World Day of the Poor, it is timely for us to stop and reflect on the Christian imperative to listen for and respond to those in need.

In his recent apostolic exhortation, Dilexi Te. Pope Leo powerfully outlines that the case for caring for those in poverty dates back thousands of years. Drawing on the prophets, the example of the saints, recent Church documents and most especially the life and teaching of Jesus, the Holy Father makes it clear that the preferential option for the poor is essential to "the burning heart of the Church's mission".

He reminds us that we are always at risk of replacing the truth of the Gospel with the so -called wisdom of this world - one that can sanctify greed and excess.

We, the Bishops of Aotearoa New Zealand, stand with Pope Leo in encouraging everyone to consider how we can each make care for the poor an integral part of our faith lived with authenticity and zeal.
