Jesus’ 3-fold tempting by the devil

THE LENTEN JOURNEY THAT WE HAVE BEGUN IS FRAMED BY TWO POWERFUL SYMBOLS: ASHES ON OUR HEADS AND WATER ON OUR FEET. These words of Bishop Tonino Bello, an Italian known for his prophetic witness to peace, justice, and care for the poor, capture something profound about this sacred season. The road may appear short, barely the distance between head and feet, yet in truth it is far longer and more demanding, for it calls not only for external practices but for a conversion of mindset — one that leads us to bend down and reach the feet of others.

As we walk these days of Lent, we hold in our hearts the countless lives turned to ashes — homes and villages erased, places of worship shattered, cities reduced to ruins; lives broken by violence; and forests consumed by fires that scar our common home. We also remember the feet of those we encounter daily, as well as the feet of those who travel far and suffer greatly in search of safety, dignity, and hope. I witnessed this myself at the border in Agua Prieta, where many are expelled back to Mexico carrying a white bag with their few belongings, often barefoot and without documents, at grave risk of falling again into the hands of human traffickers and cartels.

Think of those treated inhumanely, abused, detained, sentenced, or even executed without due process or trial. Like the wounded man on the road to Jericho, their stories call us not to pass by on the other side, but to stop, draw near, and show mercy (cf. Luke 10:33-34). They remind us that every step matters, that every act of solidarity and compassion counts, and that to follow Christ is to walk with those whose feet are tired and wounded.


